The Safeguarding Adults Board is made up of services

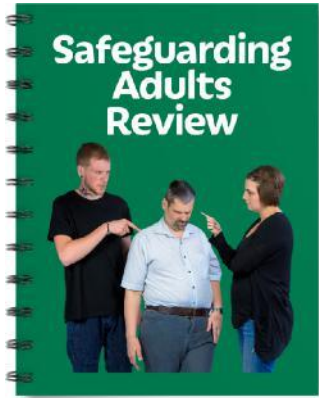
These services work together to help keep people safe from abuse or neglect



The Board has a Chairperson and an independent person to advise

We have small groups that work together to improve safeguarding support





We carry out Safeguarding Adult Reviews.

A review looks at what happened to the person and how services worked together



We need to learn and make things better for other adults to keep them safe



For example, Hampshire & Isle of Wight Fire & Rescue Service started a fire safety campaign with the NHS and local pharmacies



They want to teach people about the fire risk with some skin creams

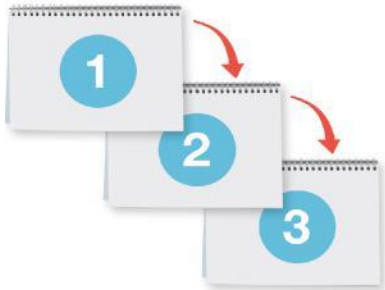




We have listened to people by doing surveys, talking to groups, and working with advocates
